

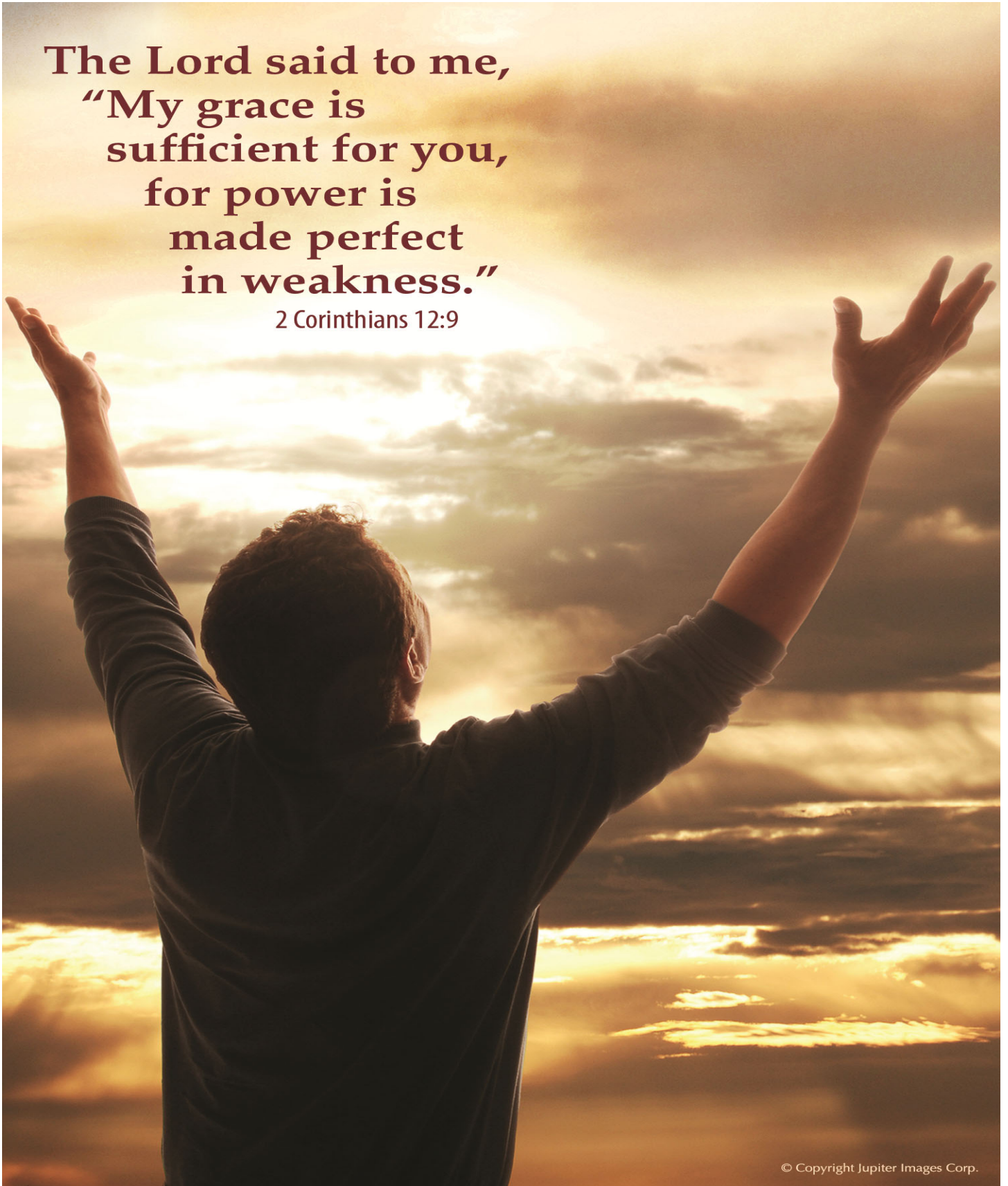

Training will continue on July 18, 25 and August 1st from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm each day.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

Have you been thinking about becoming a Catholic someday?

Adults enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through a process called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or RCIA. Those who have never been baptized look forward to the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. The Baptism of those from other Christian traditions is deeply respected. In their case, preparation leads to Confirmation and Eucharist as they enter into full Communion with the Catholic Church. Baptized Catholics who have not yet received Confirmation and First Communion may also prepare for the sacraments through this process.

The Three Days that are the highlight of the year are March 24, 25 & 26, 2016. The Easter Vigil on March 26th will be the time for Baptisms, Confirmations and First Communions for those completing their initiation journey.

Here at Our Lady of Prompt Succor we use *The Symbolon series*, a compelling presentation of the Catholic faith that provides a clear and comprehensive understanding of what the Catholic Church teaches and how to live it.
