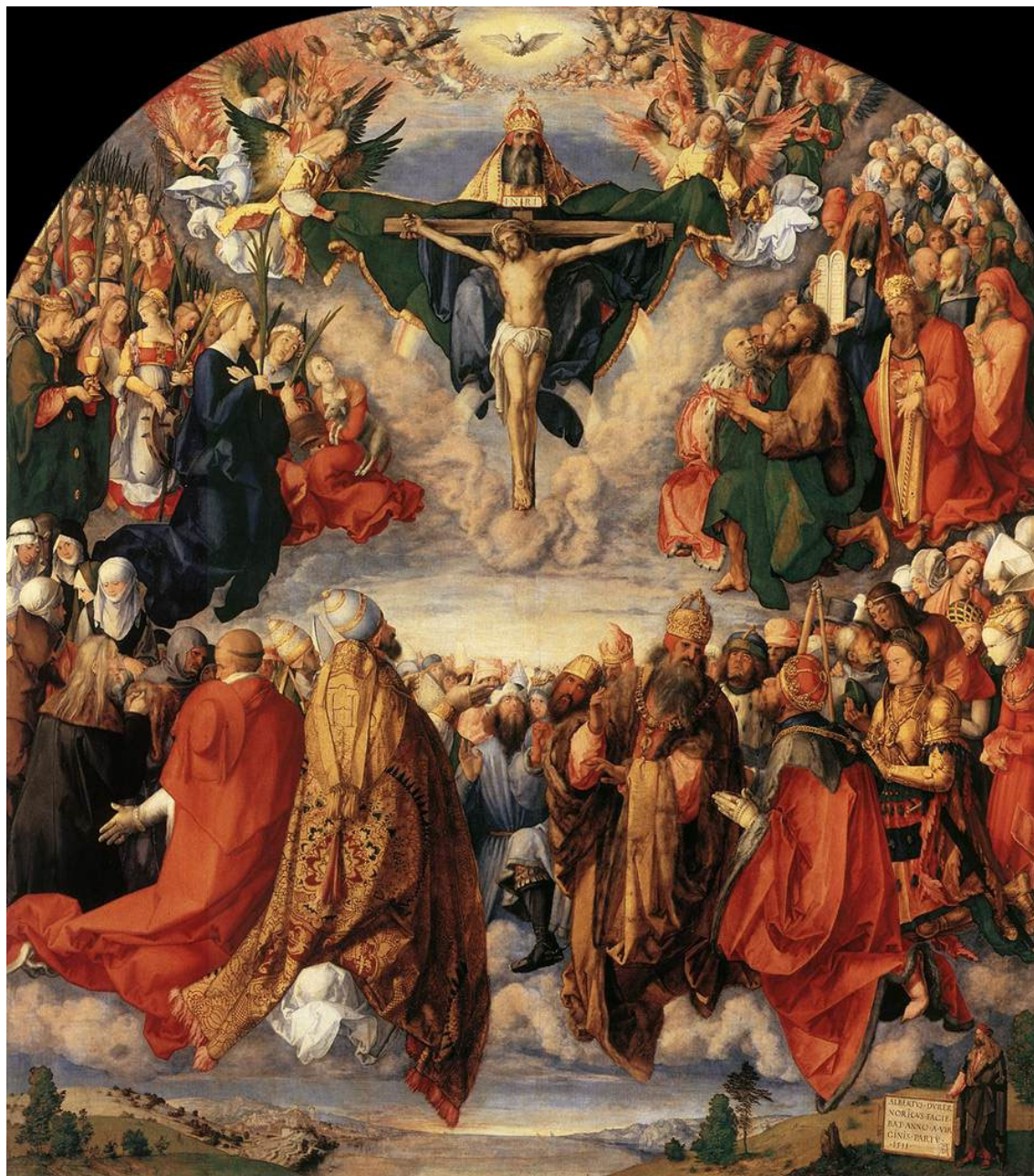

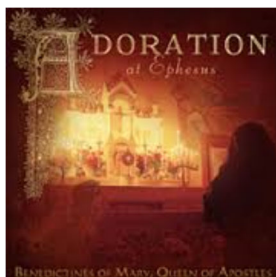
ADORATION AT EPHEBUS

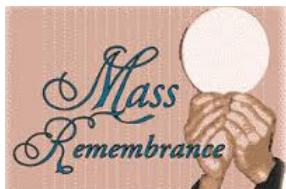
