**RETURN TO THE LORD
CAPITAL CAMPAIGN**

Everyone is being asked to consider a sacrificial gift

The *Return to the Lord* Capital Campaign is in motion and will kick-off at our parish soon. We hope to reach out to every person in the diocese, as we know each person can help accomplish so much. When we are asked to do something big, whether that is a project or a donation, it is often easiest to take the biggest piece and divide it into smaller parts. Making your gift into a pledge can help maximize your ability to support the worthy goals of the *Return to the Lord* Capital Campaign.

Breaking down payments into annual, semi-annual, quarterly or even monthly payments can help you budget your gift.

If a family of four is asked to consider a gift of \$3,600 to the campaign, that amount may seem like too much to do at one time. If the family divides it annually, it may seem more manageable at \$1,200 over three years. But, even more manageable, if the family breaks it down even further, it would come out to \$100 per month over three years, or about the amount a family of four might spend eating dinner out at a restaurant during the month.

Soon, Bishop Provost will ask each of us to consider a gift in the hopes that all of us pledge to support the campaign's important goals in some way. He is asking us to ask ourselves: What can we sacrifice for the next three years and return to the Lord for these Diocesan and Parish goals?
