2016-2017 RCIA CLASSES

Have you been thinking about becoming a Catholic someday? Adults enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through a process called Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or RCIA. Those who have never been baptized look forward to the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. The Baptism of those from other Christian traditions is deeply respected. In their case, preparation leads to Confirmation and Eucharist as they enter into full Communion with the Catholic Church. Baptized Catholics who have not yet received Confirmation and First Communion may also prepare for the sacraments through this process.

The Three Days that are the highlight of the year are April 13, 14 & 15, 2017. The Easter Vigil on Saturday, April 15, 2017 at 5:00 PM will be the time for Baptisms, Confirmations, and First Communions for those completing their initiation journey.

RETURN TO THE LORD CAPITAL CAMPAIGN
