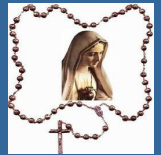

## RETURN TO THE LORD CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

### How will the *Return to the Lord* Campaign support our Priests?

We have an aging Priest population. That leaves us with two clear, moral obligations. We must:

#### 1) Take care of our retired priests.

The Priest Retirement Fund provides a dignified retirement for our priests who have spent their lives in service to God. Twelve Priests are expected to retire in the next 10 years. This represents 35 percent of all active, diocesan Priests in the Diocese. The funds from the campaign will ensure that we meet our ongoing obligation to our current and future priests.

#### 2) Focus on encouraging our priestly vocations

The Seminarian Education Fund fuels the Diocese's efforts to attract quality young men to the religious life. Recent efforts by the Diocese have been successful in recruiting a record-breaking number of 15 men to the seminary. For our Diocese, that positive trend appears likely to continue. Funds of the campaign will be endowed so interest earned can be used to help cover the annual cost of educating and forming our future Priests.

To date, our parish is 50 % toward our goal raising \$360,592 in pledges to reach our goal of \$727,736. Please continue your prayers to help us in this important campaign.
