SOUP AND SALAD

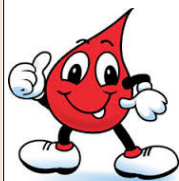

Why does the Church have to approve the text of the Scriptures we read at Mass? Learn how translators, for better or worse, carry into their work their own theological perspectives and why these ultimately shape how you pray.

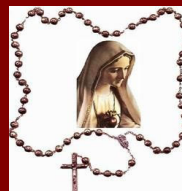
