## A MESSAGE FROM FR. THOMPSON

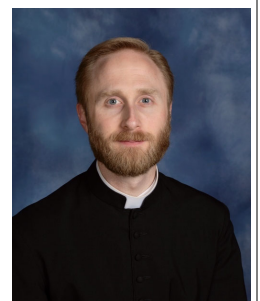

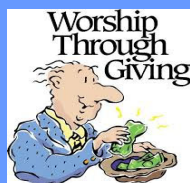

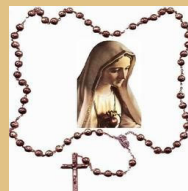
