LENTEN REGULATIONS

ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY

Days of fast and abstinence. The obligation to abstain from meat binds Catholics 14 years of age and older. The obligation to fast, limiting oneself to one full meal, binds Catholics from the age of 18 to 59.

OTHER FRIDAYS OF LENT

Also days of abstinence from meat.

FRIDAYS OF THE YEAR OUTSIDE OF LENT

Abstaining from meat is the traditional way of observing these days of penance, other serious sacrifices and penances may substitute outside of Lent.

While the season of Lent is the primary period of Catholic penitential practices, these regulations are not intended to limit the occasions for Christian penance. The practice of spiritual discipline is always appropriate during periods of special need for the individual and the

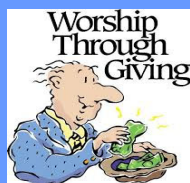
