TODAY'S READINGS

Gospel at the Procession with Palms -- Jesus' entry into Jerusalem (Matthew 21:1-11).

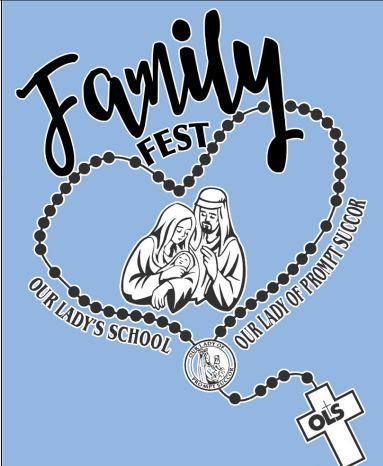
