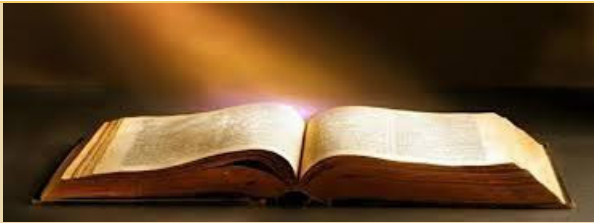

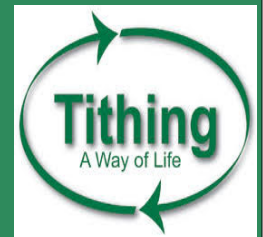
TITHING

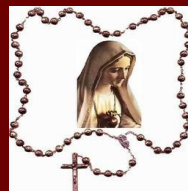
