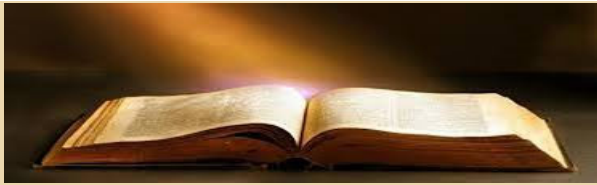

As most of you may know, Father D. B. Thompson will be leaving our Parish at the end of July to further his studies in Cannon Law at Catholic University of America in Washington, D. C.

Dear Friends in Christ,

I would like to ask your help in a serious matter. We have three air conditioning units in the church building that are completely out of service. One unit in the rectory must be replaced, as well. Since we have 24 separate units in our facilities, we can expect an ongoing need in this regard. We have been replacing and repairing these units over time, but some of these units can no longer be repaired.

The units that have stopped working are the following: one in the chapel, one in the sanctuary in the church itself, and the unit in the library. The good news is that the library unit has been in use since the church was built! In addition to these, we have a unit in the rectory that does not cool the bedrooms sufficiently and needs to be replaced.

Unfortunately, in these warm days, the temperature in the bedrooms in the rectory rises to up 80 degrees or more. Beyond that, since the air conditioners in the church do not sufficiently cool the cry room, the plan is to move the current rectory unit to the cry room and replace that smaller unit in the rectory with one that is sufficient to cool the six bedrooms with individual controls for each room. The total cost will amount to about fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00).

The cost of all of this is too much for us to absorb in our regular operating expenses and is certainly outside our budget. I would very much appreciate it if you would consider a donation to help cover this expense. I know there are many monetary demands on you these days and I am sorry that we have to ask for this. If we could do this some other way, I would not ask.

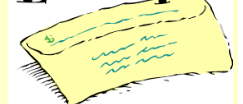

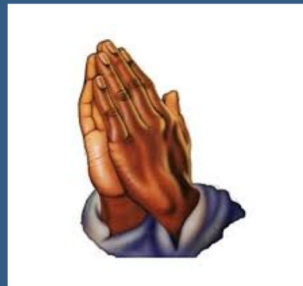
