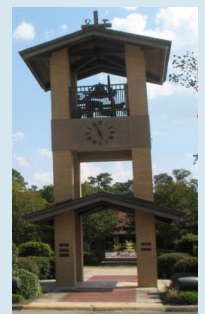
ALTAR FLOWERS

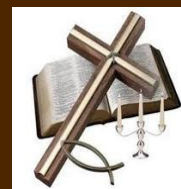

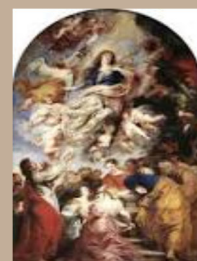

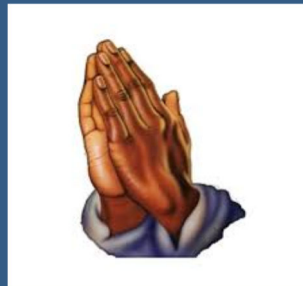
