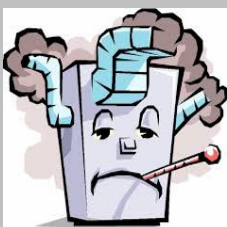


OLPS AIR CONDITIONER FUND UPDATE

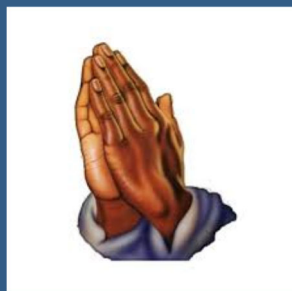

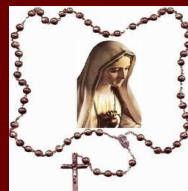
