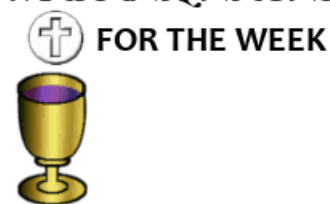
There may also be a delay with the Fed Ex delivery after the hurricane for future bulletins.

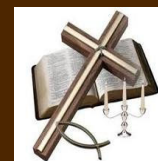

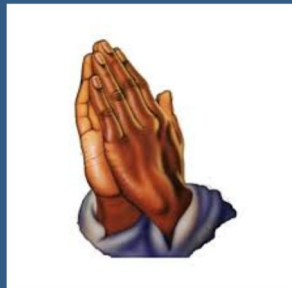

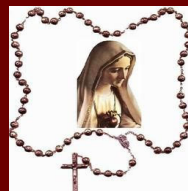
