CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

The Capital Campaign continues its collection phase. At this point, we are at approximately 39% of the pledged goals. This is about \$8.5 million that has been received. The Diocese has made two Parish Share Payments to the Parishes. One in February 2017 that covered payments received from December 2015 through June 2016. The second Parish Share was made in July 2017, which covered payments received from July 2016 through December 2016. The total paid was \$954,948.71. The next parish share will be made in January 2018 and it will reflect the period between January 2017 through June 2017.

As of this date, our Parish has received \$24,993.21. We will begin the renovation of the Parish Office for safety.



ST. LOUIS HIGH SCHOOL

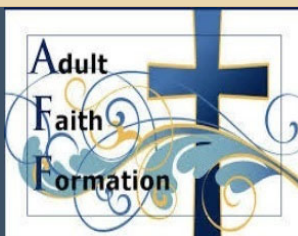

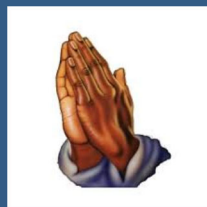
