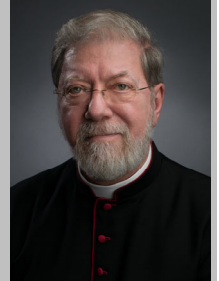

Sessions begin Thursday, February 15th, ending Thursday March 22nd, with the exception of March 1st, which is the last evening of the Lenten Mission.

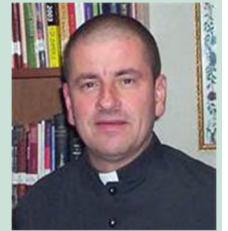

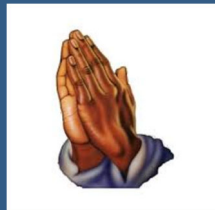
