OUR LADY OF PROMPT SUCCOR TOTAL CONSECRATION RENEWAL

Fr. Richard will celebrate Mass at 6:30 PM on February 2nd, the Feast of the Purification of Mary, during which we will make our **Total Consecration Renewal to Jesus Through Mary**. This Mass is also known as **Candlemas** because the Gospel for the Mass recalls the words of Simeon in the Gospel when Jesus is presented in the Temple: "My eyes have seen your salvation,... a light for revelation to the Gentiles and glory for your people Israel." Candles, representing the light of Christ, are blessed this day for use on the altar and for other sacred rites. On this special day, you are invited to bring for blessing devotional candles that you use at home.

NATIVITY PILGRIMAGE

Spiritual Director, Reverend Bino Francis, M.S. will be leading a thirteen day Pilgrimage to the Marian Shrines and Our Lady of LaSalette from September 11 - 23, 2017. The cost is \$3,500 per person with a \$500 non-refundable deposit per person. No reservations will be processed without a deposit. The final payment is due 90 days prior to your departure date. No deposits will be accepted 60 days prior to departure date, payment will be due in full.

Your trip includes first class hotels, double occupancy, two meals a day, breakfast and dinner, daily sight-seeing, daily Mass, airport taxes and fuel surcharges. There will be an additional fee for a private room.

Not included in your trip is lunches, group deluxe protection plan, extended cancellation protection plan, tips for your guide and driver and of course, items of a personal nature.

Some of the places you will visit will be Lisbon, the Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima, Burgos, Lourdes, Paris, and many more.
