If you would like to donate flowers in memory or honor of a loved one, please contact the Parish Office.

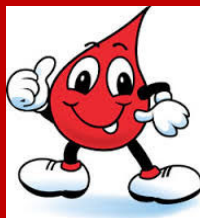
With the Easter Lilies removed, the altar is bare and there are many week-ends available for beautiful flowers on the altar.

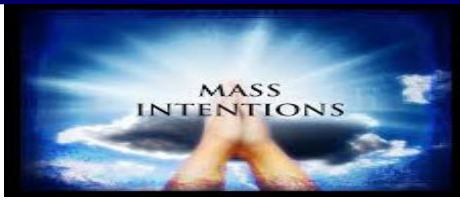

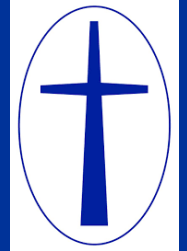

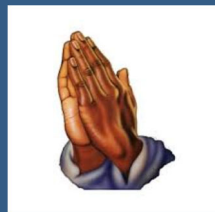
